### **Suspension of congregational prayers effective from 5<sup>th</sup> of November**

We pray that you are in the best of health and Imaan

As you are aware, over the past few months, we have worked hard to make sure measures are in place to keep our Masjid open and safe given the current pandemic situation. As you are aware the Government announced further tightening of restrictions including banning congregational prayers within places of worship. Together with other representatives we have been lobbying the government for clarity and exception given measures we have enacted, unfortunately we have not got the result we were hoping for

**In compliance with the law Masjid e Salaam will not be open for Salaah with Jamaat from Thursday 5th November** All mussallee's are requested to respect this and to not attend the masjid at Jamaat times.

The government regulations permit individual prayer, and the opening times for others to attend for individual prayer in the masjid will be published in the coming days.

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding. We urge you to continue to take all necessary steps to stop the spread of the virus and stay safe. You should continue your daily prayers and routines from home, engage in dua, recitation of the Quran, istigfar and durood.

### **Madrassa**

The Government has not published any guidance regarding Madrassahs which are classed as Out of School clubs. At the moment Madrassa will continue as Normal. If this changes, parents will be notified as soon as possible.

We pray that the Almighty, the Most Merciful, showers us with His infinite mercy and grants relief, protection and ease to all of humanity in these testing times.
